KINGS SEEDS Catalogue Orders

1 FLOWER AND VEGETABLE SEEDS:

Select seeds from Kings catalogue and complete the green order form, transforming section totals to the Summary of Totals, back page.

Add £1.20 for individual packing by Kings.

Total the sections to give your order value. Including £1.20 packing

NB Include your name, plot number, and contact number in case of errors.

Orders and payment for seeds must be received by Sunday 1st November

NB: The person named on forms must be the person on the tenancy Agreement.

2 SOFT FRUIT, plant section

Select from the Kings catalogue and complete the order form for this section and the summary order sheet including your home address for direct lorry delivery. (If separate to your seed order an additional packing charge of £1.20 is needed)

Closing date for this section: See KINGS catalogue for cut off date.

Hand in soft fruit orders with your payment at PL or HL "Sheds"

Potatoes will be sold in multiples of 1kg price £1.50 in stock from Jan/Feb2021

Potato Specials will be sold in bags of 2kg price £6.00 in stock from Jan/Feb2021

Onions will be sold bags of 500gs (1lb) price £1.50 in stock from Nov2021

Garlic will be sold bags of 100gs price £1.00 in stock from Nov 2021

A seed potato weighs between 50g and 100g depending on Variety

First early potatoes can be spaced at 30cm (12 ins) and in rows 60cm (24ins) apart

Early and main crop potatoes can be spaced at 40cm(16Ins) and in rows 75cm (30ins) apart

Assuming an average weight of 75 g seed potato. 1.5 kg is needed for a 10 m row approximately,

Which may yield about 10kg
